Next time you go to the beach, skip the sandcastle and make a sand snowman!



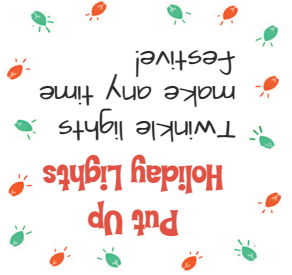
Make Paper Snowflakes
