Boating & Sailing Words

It is fun that a different language is used on boats, sailboats, and ships.
Here are some fun words to know while on your cruise.

Bow - (rhymes with cow) is the front of a ship.

Bridge - the location where the captain steers and controls the ship. It is where the captain operates or "pilots" the boat.

Buoy - (boo-wee) markers in the water to let captains know where to pilot their boat or ship. Like lane markers you see on the road.

Channel - the path for ships to follow in the water. Marked with buoys, the channel is the ship's path to avoid shallow and dangerous areas.

Chart - when on a boat or ship, instead of a map, it is called a chart.

Crew - the name for all the people who operate the ship.

Deck - what the floor of a ship is called.

Galley - where the chefs cook and prepare all the food. It is called a galley on a ship instead of a kitchen.

Line - instead of calling it rope, it is called "line" when you're on a boat or ship.

Pilot - instead of "driving" a boat or ship, it is called piloting. *The captain was piloting the ship, headed for the tropical island.*

Port - where a ship docks to load and unload passengers, suitcases, and supplies.

Port Side - When you are on a boat, facing forward, this is the "left" side of a ship. You can remember because *port* has four letters, and the word *left* has four letters.

Ship - a BIG boat is referred to as a ship. And a cruise ship sure is a big boat!

Starboard Side - the "right" side of a boat.

Stern - is the back of a boat.

After spending the day riding water slides and playing in the most beautiful clear blue waters, it was time to head back to the ship to wash up for dinner.

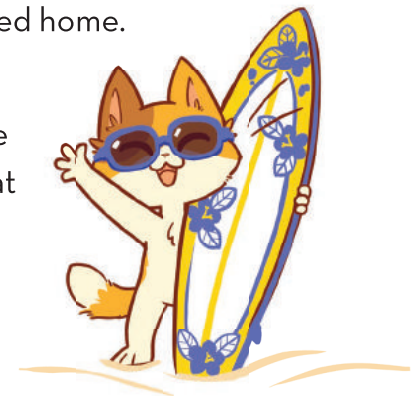
The meals were delicious. There were so many different types of food to try. KeeKee enjoyed the buffet because she got to try new foods and go back for a little more of what she liked.

Decks

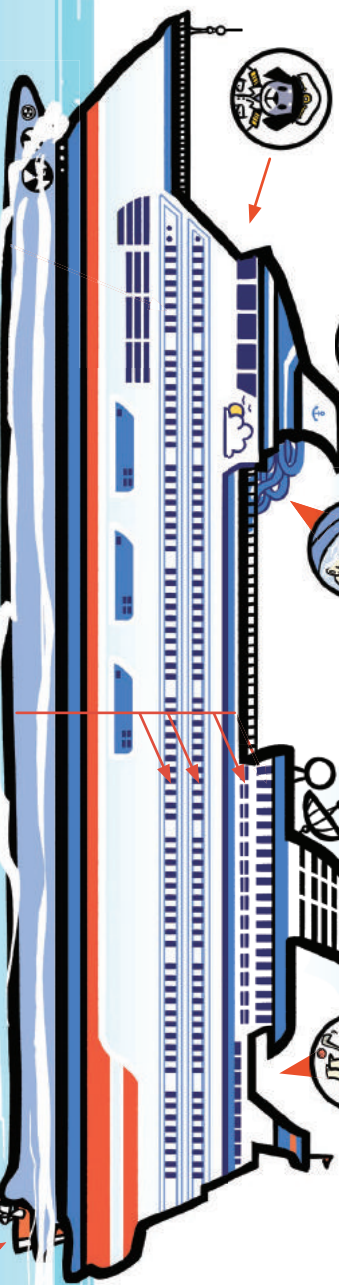
The decks are the different floors or levels of a cruise ship.
